PATTERN =8-April - Centennial Star Fabric Key =1 = background, #2 = medium, #3= dark



Cutting instructions:

- 1. Cut 1 square 7½" and 4 squares 3½" background fabric. Subcut the 7½" square twice diagonally as shown to get 4 triangles.
- 2. Cut 1 strip 25/8" of medium fabric. Subcut into four lengths 43/4".
- 3. Cut 1 square 4¾" and 2 squares 4¼" of dark fabric. Subcut the 4¼" squares twice diagonally as shown to get 8 triangles.

Piecing instructions:


1. Stitch 2 dark triangles on adjacent sides of the 3½" background square matching the center of the block and triangle. (#1). Press to the dark triangles. Make 4 of these units. Stitch these units to the 4¾" medium rectangle (#2) matching the center of the rectangle to the center point. Press to the medium rectangle. Stitch the large background triangles to opposite sides of two of the units (#3). Press to the background triangle.







- 2. Stitch two of the above units (#2) to opposite sides of the center dark 4¾" square. Press towards the center square.
- 3. Stitch the remaining side units (#3) to the opposite sides of the block, matching the intersecting seams. Press to the center unit again.
