

Cutting Instructions

Background Fabric: Cut (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for HST (half square triangles). Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side. Cut (4) 3" squares for block corners.

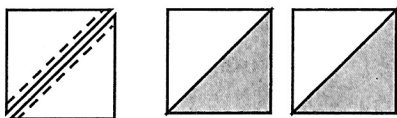
Medium Fabric: Cut (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for HST (half square triangles).

Dark Fabric: Cut (4) 3" squares for inside of corner units.

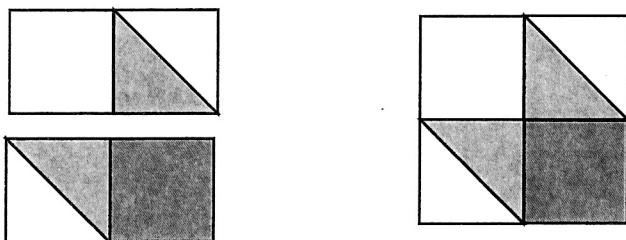
Accent Fabric: Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Piecing Instructions

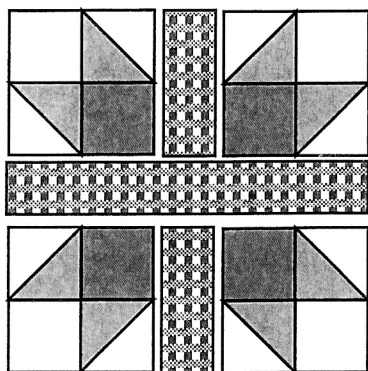
- 1) Place a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " background square onto a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " medium square right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press toward the medium fabric. Square up to 3" x 3". Repeat 3 more times to make 8 HST (half square triangle). Have a Bloc-Loc® or Tucker Trimmer®? Use it here!



- 2) Sew HST's and squares together as shown; press toward the squares. Sew these units together to make corner units. Press. Make 4. Units measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".



- 3) Piece block together with accent rectangles as shown:
