Our guild is in charge of the Judged Quilts again – so our experienced hangers & helpers are needed. They will all need to have a 4-inch opening on the sleeve (for hanging) – which must be sewn on (no safety pins). Laura will NOT put them on. They also need to have a label, which does not need to be permanent.

Community Service – Dianna Cook has kits available for the Hug Quilts, we need 15 – 20 hug quilts for local nursing homes (kits are available). The nursing homes would also like lap quilts – approximately 32" x 45" & remember to use materials that are machine washable (as all items are washed in hot water).
