Background cutting chart

**PATTERN #7 March - Western Star**

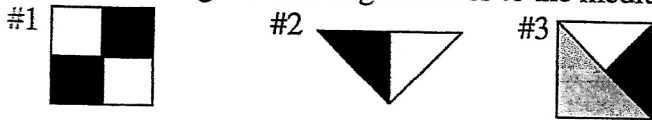
Fabric Key #1 = background, #2 = medium, #3 = dark

**Cutting instructions :**

1. Cut 1 square 5 1/4", 4 squares 4 1/2" and 2 squares 2 1/2" of background fabric. Subcut the 5 1/4" square diagonally twice to get 4 triangles 
2. Cut 2 squares 4 1/2" of medium fabric. Subcut each once diagonally to get 4 triangles. 
3. Cut 1 square 5 1/4" and 2 squares 2 1/2" of dark fabric. Subcut the 5 1/4" square diagonally twice to get 4 triangles. 

**Piecing instructions:**

1. (#1) Stitch the 2 background and dark 2 1/2" squares into a 4 patch as diagrammed. (#2). Stitch the small background triangles to the small dark triangles exactly as diagrammed. Press to the dark fabric. (#3) Layer the background/dark combination triangle unit on top of the medium triangles. Stitch carefully to avoid stretching the bias edges. Press to the medium large triangles.



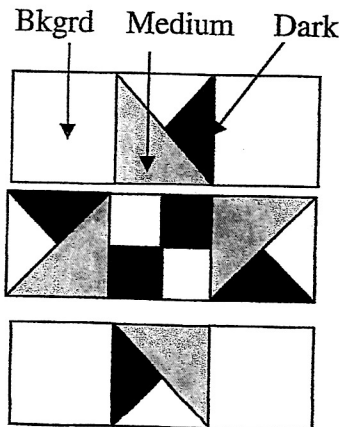
2. Stitch two of the above units (#3) to opposite sides of the center 4 patch unit. Notice placement. Press center 4 patch unit.



3. Stitch the 4 1/2" background squares to the opposite sides of the remaining #3 units. Press to the outer corner units.



4. Stitch block together in rows as diagrammed.
