


PATTERN #2 October - Evening Star Fabric Key #1 = background, #2 = medium, #3= dark



Cutting chart for background fabric.

Cutting instructions:

- 1. Cut 1 square 7 1/4", 1 square 4" and 6 squares 3 1/2" of background fabric. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the back of the 4" square.
- 2. Cut 4 squares 4" of medium fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of these squares.
- 3. Cut 1 square 4" of dark fabric.


Piecing instructions:


- 1. (A) Place two of the medium 4" squares on opposite corners of the 7 1/4" background square right sides together. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. (B)Cut on the drawn line. (C)Press to the dark triangles. You will get 2 units. (D)Place another 4" background square on the corner of the large triangle. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line again. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the triangles. Repeat with the other large triangle unit. You will get 4 finished flying geese units. Trim geese units to 6 1/2" x 3 1/2. (A) (B) (C)
- 2. Place the 4" background square right sides together onto the 4" dark square. Stitch ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press toward the dark triangle to get a total of 2 half square triangle units.

 Trim squares to 3 ½".
- 3. Stitch the 2 half square triangles together with 2 of the 3½" squares as shown.




4. Stitch 2 of the flying geese units on opposite sides of the center square. Press to the center. Then add the 4 remaining 3½ squares to opposite ends of the remaining flying geese units.





5. Assemble block in rows as diagrammed. Press top and bottom rows towards the outside corners. Press the middle row towards the center square. Press the long horizontal seams towards the center row.
