Honoring Our Women Veterans at KCRQF

- Each guild will submit their listing of veterans with one (1) email to Attention Lynda Loomis @ contact@kcrqf.com
Please include the following information: Name of Veteran, Rank, Branch of Service, Tour of Duty, MOS- Military Occupational Service, Locations Served, Current Mailing Address, Phone number, Email address.
- Each guild is allowed to enter 6 women veterans to be awarded a quilt. Guilds can choose which of their quilts to go to which vet. Guilds can offer additional names for a waiting list in case we have guilds that cannot reach the six (6), First consideration is for Veterans - not active military.
- 100 Honor Quilts - to be constructed by 17 guilds - each guild crafting approx. 6 quilts. Size 60"w x 80"l - if your guild cannot craft these quilts - bring this to our attention immediately.
- Batting - donations of Hobbs batting will be coming by Aug/Sept 2026 for our use.
- Fabrics top + backing - currently we have received enough fabric for each Guild to make 3 quilts. While we are still gathering - guilds are welcome to use donations from their members to supplement. If you do not use the fabrics donated to KCRQF please return it so it can be used for quilt prizes.
- Hanging Sleeve is required - standard style/size

IMPORTANT TO REMIND YOUR QUILDS OF THE Showcase Challenge - Open Now - **Registration due December 31, 2026** Visit the website for details - this is available to KCRQF guild members ONLY

Community Service Opportunities for Youth organizations - Vendors often need additional labor for move-in, move-out. KCRQF will allow youth organizations such as Scouts, Church youth groups or other pre-approved organizations to apply. Adult supervision from the youth organization leadership must be on site for supervision and safety reasons. KCRQF will notify vendors of possibilities and make a suggestion rate to be \$15 per hour. KCRQF is NOT responsible for managing this opportunity - vendors will be directed to communicate directly to Youth Organizations.

Group Tickets Sales - opening soon. Special pricing for Single Day tickets - groups of 12 or more \$14 per ticket (guilds can take advantage of this but tickets must be purchased in bulk (12 or more at time)

ITEMS OPENING IN JANUARY 2027 - Event Tickets - single or 3 day, Merchandise, Classes, Judged Quilt Registration

Volunteer Sign up Dates: Preview in March 2027, LIVE Sign up in April 2027 - specific dates to come in 2027. The current goal is each guild will provide approximately 150 hours from volunteers. PLEASE NOTE - if a guild uses labor such as husbands or young adults/teens these individuals must be a member of the guild. This is a requirement of the insurance covering this event. Each guild must add them to their roster as a "guest" member or "temporary" member. KCRQF will require an undated roster listing prior to the festival.

Guild Opportunity Quilts - photos and descriptions are needed as soon as available or no later than January 2027

Guild Quilt Registration - Coming in March 2027

Ticket Pricing: Ticket prices will remain the same as 2025 as follows

- Single Day = purchased in advance online = \$16
- 3-Day ticket = \$32
- Youth - under 10 = FREE
- Youth - 11-18 yrs of age = \$10
- Group ticket prices - groups of 12 or more = \$14 per ticket
- Day of Festival - single day ticket = \$20 (once the festival has opened there will be NO 3 day tickets available)
- ** NEW - Veterans Day - Saturday ONLY - \$10 ticket
