November - Texas

Colors – Red, White & Navy

Cutting Instructions:

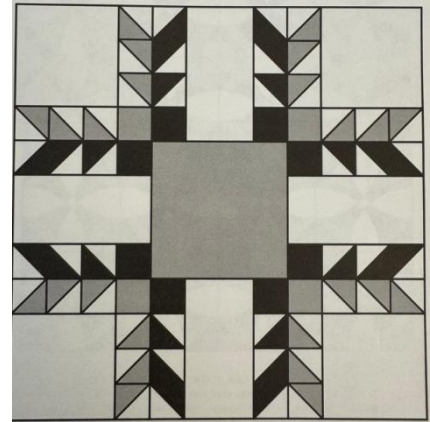
Piece A – Cut 4 white 3-1/2” squares (corners)

Piece B – Cut 8 Navy and 4 Red = 1-1/2” squares

Piece C – cut 6 white, 3 red, 3 navy = 4-1/4” squares to make HSTs.

Piece D – cut 4 white 2-1/2” x 4-1/2” rectangles

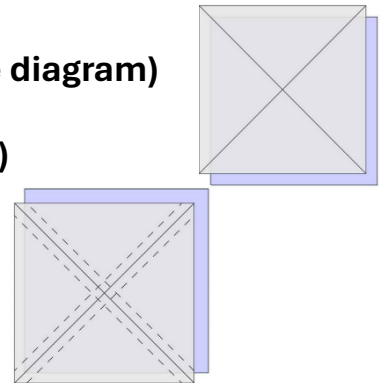
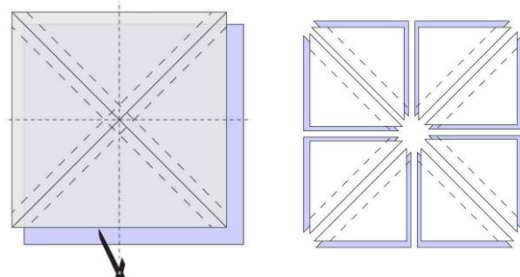
Piece E - cut 1 white or red 4-1/2” square



Half Square Triangle Sewing Instructions:

Make Half Square Triangles with the “C” Squares (white & red and white & navy). Diagram for 8 HST:

1. Draw diagonal lines on the white squares (per the diagram)
2. Place right sides together (1 white & 1 other color)
3. Stich 1/4” on both sides of both diagonal lines
4. Cut on each diagonal line and down the middle (top to bottom and left to right)



5. Press to set the stitching and then open the block, pressing towards the dark fabric. **Trim to 1-1/2” squares**

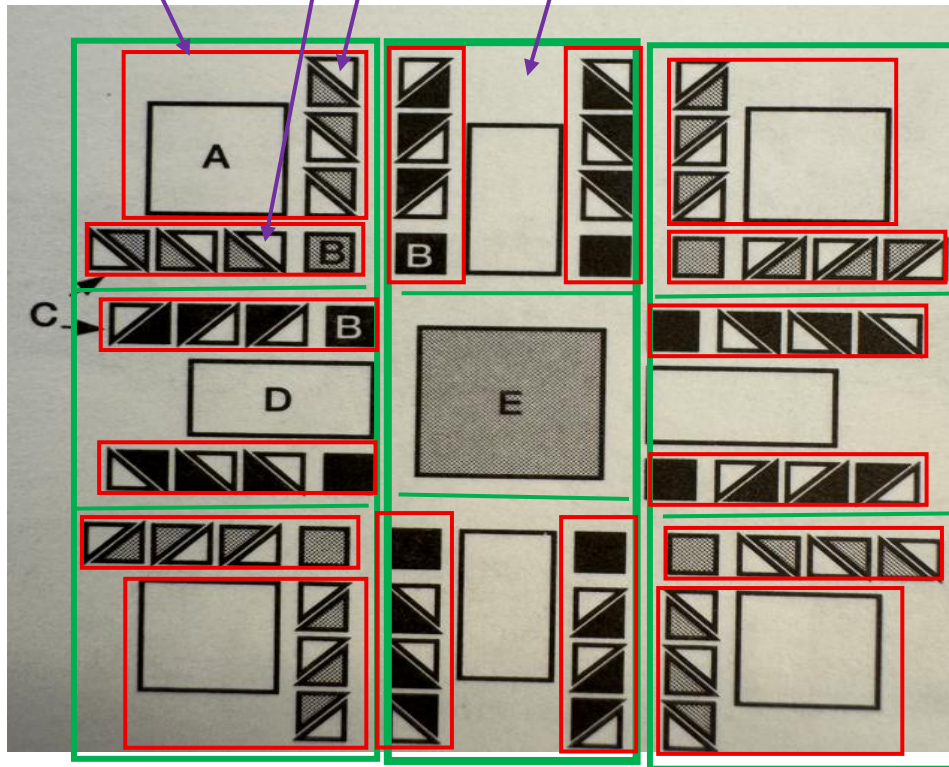
6. Repeat with remaining “C” fabric.

You will have 24 white & red squares and 24 white & navy squares when you are done with this step.

Arrange per diagram below.

**#1 Box - Sew HST's together and
Then sew to "A".
Repeat for all corner boxes.**

**#2 Box - Sew HST's together
and then sew to rectangle.
Repeat for all 4 middle boxes.**



Sew the boxes in each column together.

Then sew the columns together.
